A tough time for an iconic Canadian singer yields an important new album of touching, heartfelt songs, with a “new voice.”

The last two years have been a time of dramatic change in the life of the iconic Canadian songwriter Ian Tyson. Going through a difficult divorce and another broken love affair, he faced his 75th birthday in September with a mixture of satisfaction and regret.

Now, thanks to a stubborn virus, Tyson has what he calls “a new voice”—grainier, grittier, and more immediately intimate than his former one, familiar to Canadians for more than four decades.

- His first album of new songs since 2005’s “Songs From the Gravel Road.” His 14th record for Stony Plain.
- Tyson’s solo releases have sold over 500,000 units in Canada.
- Tyson is not letting the years slow him down; he will continue to tour, both in Canada and the U.S., to promote the new album.
- Produced in Nashville by Harry Stinson (Steve Earle, Rodney Crowell, Marty Stuart and Corb Lund).
- Two tracks (Blaino’s Song and Ross Knox) were recorded in Edmonton with his touring players and backup singers, Gord Maxwell (bass) and Gord Matthews (guitar).
- Tyson’s new songs reflect two difficult years as Canada’s most iconic songwriter faces the prospect of his senior years. “Growing old is not for wimps,” he says—and his legion of fans will understand and fight the future with him.
- Emphasis tracks: “My Cherry Coloured Rose,” about Don Cherry and written by Jay Aymar; and the ballad “Yellowhead To Yellowstone,” co-written with Stuart MacDougall.
- Tyson’s songs have been recorded by Neil Young, Johnny Cash, Bob Dylan and Blue Rodeo, just to mention a few.
